The Doctoral Workshop is a Satellite Event of the 3<sup>rd</sup> International Conference on Dynamics in Logistics – LDIC 2012 (www.ldic-conference.org). The LDIC is held in conjunction with the new conference "Impact of Virtual, Remote, and Real Logistics Labs" – ImViReLL'12 (imvirell.org).
